Born in Cinisi (Palermo) on May 4, 1948.

Graduated with honors in Medicine (1972). Post-graduated with honors in CV Diseases (1976), Internal Medicine (1982), Medical Angiology (1985). Fellow (1973-1980), Researcher (1980 to 1987), Associate Professor of Clinical Pathophysiology (University of Catania in 1988-1993 and University of Palermo in 1993-2001), full Professor of CV Diseases (2001-today), University of Palermo. Vice - Coordinator of the PhD in Medical Pathophysiology (2006-2008). Coordinator of the PhD in CV Sciences (2010-2013). Director of the Cardio-Angiology Section of the Department of Internal Medicine, CV and Nephro-Urological Diseases (2004-2011), of the Department of Internal Medicine and Specialities (DIMIS - 2010-2012). Director of the Section of Cardio-Respiratory and Endocrino-Metabolic Diseases of the Biomedical Department of Internal Medicine and Specialities (DIBIMIS – since 2013). Director of the II Level Master on Vascular Diseases (since 2007) and on Echocardiography (from 2007). Director of the post-graduate School of Cardiology (2003-2010) and of Cardiovascular Diseases (2010-2012). Director the Division of Cardiology of the University Hospital "P. Giaccone" of Palermo (since 2004). Director of the Center for Early Diagnosis of Preclinical and Multifocal Atherosclerosis and Secondary Prevention (since 2006). Director of the Reference Regional Centre for Diagnosis and Care of Heart Failure (since 2013). Teaching at the post-graduate Schools of Thoracic Surgery (1984-1986), Internal Medicine I (1988), Internal Medicine II (1985), Cardiology (1978), Geriatrics (1988) and Nephrology (1993) and since 2010 at the Schools of Anaesthesia and Intensive Care, Cardiac Surgery, Dermatology, Endocrinology, Gastroenterology, Geriatrics, Haematology, Infectious Diseases, Nephrology, Oncology, Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation, Radiology, Psychiatry, Radiotherapy, Respiratory Diseases, Urology. Member of the Executive Board and General Secretary of the Italian Society of Cardiology (1986-2002), President (2006-2010) and Past-President (2010-2014) of the Italian Heart and Circulation Foundation, President (2011-2012) and Past-President (2013-2014) of the Italian Society of Cardiology. General Secretary (1998-2001) and Councillor- Treasurer (2011-2013) and again Councillor-Secretary (since 2013) of the Italian Federation of Cardiology. Honorary member of the Academy of Medicine "Purkinje" of the University of Praha (2005), of the Italian Society of Cardiology (2012) and of the Italian Association of Cardio-Oncology (since 2012).

It is particularly engaged in developing research in the field cardiovascular disease, epidemiology and risk factors of atherosclerosis, acute and chronic ischemic heart disease, hypertension, cardiometabolic disease, peripheral vascular diseases and multifocal atherosclerosis and Takotsubo cardiomyopathy. Author of about 800 papers published in full on national and international journals with referees of which 380 appear on PubMed. Author of about 850 abstracts of communications presented at national and international conferences. He was invited to deliver Lectures in major national and international conferences.
